Topic Sentence (present the main focus of your paragraph)

- (1) Supporting Detail/Answer (A)
 - (1) Explanation/Evidence/Cite (C)
 - (2) Extend/Example (E)
- (2) Supporting Detail/Answer (A)
 - (1) Explanation/Evidence/Cite (C)
 - (2) Extend/Example (E)

Closing Statement (recap the topic sentence)

Reminder: 8 sentences

Another way to look at it:

- 1. Topic Sentence
- 2. (1) Detail (For example,...)
- 3. (1) Explanation (This means,...)
- 4. (2) Explain further (In other words,...)
- 5. (2) Detail
- 6. (1) Explanation
- 7. (2) Explain further
- 8. Closing Statement

Remember:

- 1. Indent
- 2. Topic Sentence
- 3. 1:2 Ratio
 - a. For every 1 piece of evidence, 2 sentences discussing the evidence
- 4. Closing/Transition Sentence
